A fairly tannic, structured style of Côtes-du-Rhône, with piercing acidity and fresh, saline tannins. The long, straight style is thanks no doubt to the large dollop of Syrah in the blend, but there's enough flesh to give it good southern character.

Deep pink, with some vibrancy to the raspberry fruits here. Full-bodied and rounded on the palate, it has generous, juicy strawberry and a touch of Victoria plum. There's real concentration of flavour here, and the finish is long. One of the best Côtes-du-Rhône rosés by a mile.
